## Year 1 Optional Home Learning



This is a takeaway menu of home learning for you and your child to choose from should you wish to complete any activities at home. Please upload your completed learning onto your child's Tapestry account.



Make a model of the solar system. You could use any art or modelling materials that you have at home, e.g. empty cardboard box, paint, playdough, different sized or types of balls. Can you learn the names of the planets? Do you know which order the planets are in within the solar system?



Login to Education City using your account details that we sent home last half term. Play the games that we have allocated to you in the classwork section. These games have been chosen specifically to reinforce some of the learning that we are completing in school this half term.

Find out about the stars in the sky and the constellations they make. You could present this information however you like, e.g. using drawing, writing sentences or creating something on the computer.



Research a famous astronaut and make a poster about them. You could use non-fiction books or the internet to find out some facts. Think about how you could present the information. Can you add pictures or appropriate decoration to your poster to make people want to read it.



Spend some time practising your number bonds for the numbers within and including 10 and the bonds to 20, so that you can recall them quickly. The Hit the Button game on the Top Marks website is a fun way to practise.
