<i>country</i>	A country is land that is controlled by a single government.
<i>population</i>	The number of people that live in a particular place.
<i>landmark</i>	A well-known building or place.
<i>atlas</i>	A book of maps or charts.

## Continent Facts

- Asia is the largest continent.
- Half of the world's **population** live in Asia.
- Africa is the continent with the most **countries**.
- South America is the continent with the fewest countries (apart from Antarctica).
- The largest desert in the world (the Sahara) is in Africa.
- North America is twice the size of Europe.
- Over half of Australia is **desert** or receives little rain.
- The Amazon **rainforest** is in South America.
- Antarctica is known as the 'frozen continent.'
