Continent Facts

- Asia is the largest continent.
- Half of the world's population live in Asia.
- Africa is the continent with the most countries.
- South America is the continent with the fewest countries (apart from Antarctica).
- The largest desert in the world (the Sahara) is in Africa.
- North America is twice the size of Europe.
- Over half of Australia is desert or receives little rain.
- The Amazon **rainforest** is in South America.
- Antarctica is known as the 'frozen continent.'
