You could find the poem in a book or online. You might like to add some actions to help you remember the words. We would love to see and hear your poem via a recording on Tapestry.</p>	 <p>Spend some time practising your number bonds for the numbers within and including 10 and the bonds to 20, so that you can recall them quickly. Resources for this task can be found on a Tapestry post.</p>	<p>Visit the local library and borrow some non-fiction books about animals. Can you show your grownups at home how to use a contents page? What new facts can you find out about different animals? We would love to hear your animal facts on Tapestry.</p>
<p>Create a piece of artwork to show us your favourite animal. You could use any type of art materials that you have at home. Look carefully at your animal's special markings, do they have any prints that you could include in your artwork?</p>	<p>In Science week, we will be learning all about birds. You could include information about what the animal looks like, where it lives, what it eats (carnivore, herbivore or omnivore) and which group it belongs to (mammal, fish, bird, reptile or amphibian.) You could design the fact file yourself or use a computer to help you.</p>
