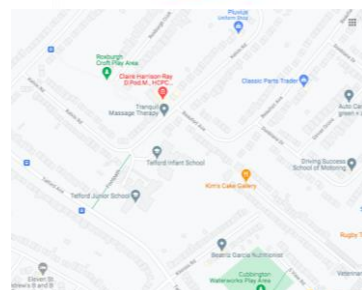


Autumn 2 – All Around Me Year 1 Optional home learning



This is a takeaway menu of home learning for you and your child to choose from should you wish to complete any home learning. Please share any of the activities that you complete with us on Tapestry.



This term we will be looking at maps and creating our own. Can you create a map of your own? You might like to create a map of a room in your home, your local area around where you live or a place you have visited.



Make a collection of sticks and pebbles. Use the sticks or pebbles to make a 2D shape. What shape did you make? Can you tell a grown-up about your shape? How many sides does your shape have? Then, try making another shape. Can you make a triangle, a square or rectangle?

Choose an object at home and don't let your grown up see it. Give your grown up clear clues to guess what the object is. Remember to describe the object, including the materials it is made from to help you. Take it turns with your adult to guess what the item is.

Create a drawing or painting of your favourite place in your local area. Go outside and sit down to sketch it if possible. Or, ask an adult to photograph it for you to copy.



With a grownup, go for a walk in the local area around Telford Infant School. How many different types of buildings can you see? What are they used for? How are the buildings the same and how are they different? Take some photographs of the different buildings that you see.

Write a letter to a friend or family member to share some news with them. Remember to include the address of the person writing it, the date, the name of who the letter is to and the name of who the letter is from – you.
