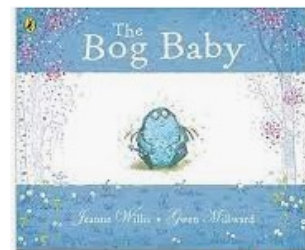







# Spring 2 – Into the Woods

## Year 1 Optional home learning



This is a takeaway menu of home learning for you and your child to choose from should you wish to complete any home learning. Please upload onto Tapestry anything that you create to share with the class.



<p>Choose a simple poem or rhyme and see if you can learn it off by heart at home with your grownups. You could find the poem in a book or online. You might like to add some actions to help you remember the words. We would love to see and hear your poem via a recording on Tapestry.</p> 	<p>In Maths, we shall be learning how to use a ruler accurately to measure the length and height of objects. Using a ruler at home, can you find and measure 5 items that are longer than 20cm and 5 items that are shorter than 5 times? As an extra challenge, you could order your items from shortest to longest.</p> 	<p>Later on in this half term, we shall be learning about plants in Science. You might like to grow some seeds at home and observe them as they grow. You could keep a diary to show what happens to the seeds as they grow; your diary could be pictures or pictures and sentences.</p> 
<p>Create a piece of artwork to show us your favourite animal. You could use any type of art materials that you have at home. Look carefully at your animal's special markings, do they have any prints that you could include in your artwork?</p> 	<p>Log into Education City using your account details. Play the games/ complete the activities that we have allocated to you in the classwork section. These games have been chosen specifically to reinforce some of the learning that we are completing in school this half term.</p> 	<p>In our DT learning, we will be designing and making our own bridges. Can you make a bridge at home from junk modelling materials or a construction kit? How many play people can fit on your bridge before it collapses? How could you make your bridge stronger and more stable?</p>
