

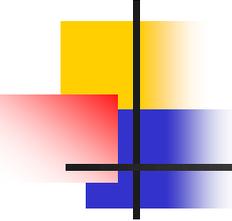

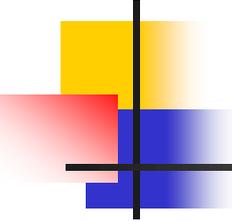

Aims of our Welcome Meetings

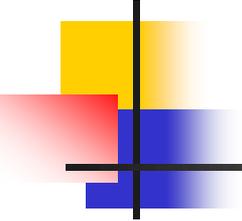
- To provide you with an opportunity to meet the year group team.

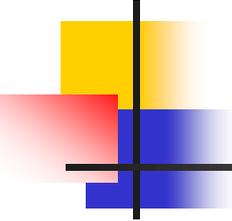

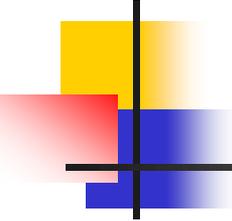

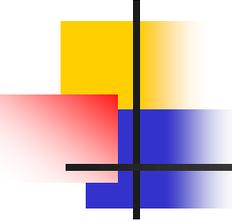
Routines

- **Attendance and punctuality**



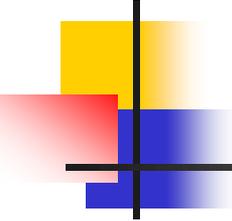
Routines

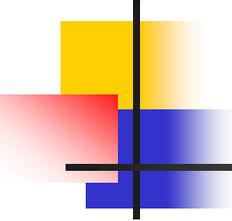
Home Learning

- Education City



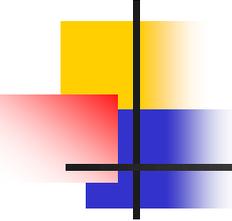
What your child needs to bring to school

- Forest Schools clothing to be advised



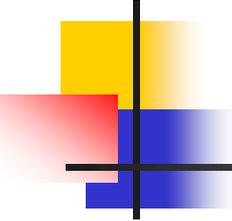

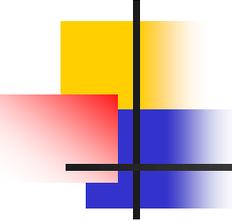
Reading

 - Visit the library



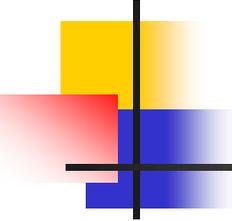
Writing

- How you can help



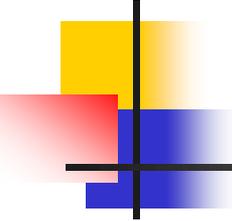
Assessment

This is an end of year judgement, but we will continue to keep you informed of your child's progress throughout the year.

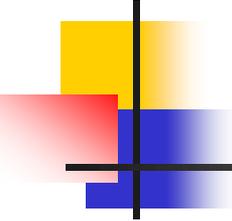
Building Learning Power

- We will let you know if your child needs wellies.



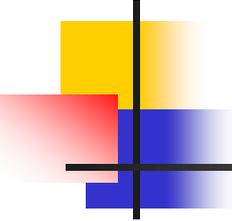


